Students enrolled in the ADN program at College of the Canyons may concurrently enroll in the bridge RN-BSN program CSUCI after they have successfully completed the 1st semester of the ADN program. Students are enrolled into the bridge program only in summer.

An overall GPA of 2.0 is required for admission to CSUCI (per CSU policy). All nursing courses must be passed with a grade of "C" or better.
