**CSU Channel Islands offers Track II programs for those who are currently enrolled in an Associate's Degree in Nursing program or hold a RN license.**

### **Requirements to be met prior to joining the Nursing Program:**

#### **ADN to BSN "Summer Bridge":**

- Current enrollment in a BRN approved pre-licensure Associate degree of Nursing program.
- Earn at least a 2.00 GPA in Pre-Nursing Core courses with no grade lower than a C.
- Become GE certified.

#### **RN to BSN programs:**

- Have or be eligible to acquire a valid California RN license.
- Be a graduate of a BRN approved pre-licensure Associate degree in Nursing program from an accredited educational institution.
- Earn at least a 2.00 GPA in Pre-Nursing Core courses with no grade lower than a C.
- Become GE certified.

## **Applying to the Nursing Program**

### **Step 1: Complete all Nursing Major Prerequisite Courses**

Complete all nursing major prerequisite courses or their equivalents with a grade of C or better by the end of the spring term prior to summer admission. **Summer coursework will not be accepted as in progress work.**

- **BIOL 210 Anatomy and Physiology I (4)**
- **BIOL 211 Anatomy and Physiology II (4)**
- **BIOL 217 Medical Microbiology (4)**
- **BioStatistics B3 (Math Category)**
- **COMM 101 Public Speaking (3)**
- **CHEM 110 Chemistry of Life (4)**  
(OR general or organic, with associated lab)
- **ENGL 105 Composition Rhetoric (3)**
- **Completion of Critical Thinking requirement**

### **"Summer Bridge" ADN to BSN Program**

#### **Step 2: Apply to CSU Channel Islands & the Nursing Program**

You must simultaneously apply to CSU Channel Islands and the Nursing Program as an ADN-BSN "Summer Bridge" major through [www.calstate.edu/apply](http://www.calstate.edu/apply). Applications are only accepted between **February 1<sup>st</sup> through April 30<sup>th</sup>**.

### **RN to BSN Programs (Full and Part-Time)**

#### **Step 2: Apply to CSU Channel Islands & the Nursing Program**

You must simultaneously apply to CSU Channel Islands and the Nursing Program as a RN-BSN major through [www.calstate.edu/apply](http://www.calstate.edu/apply). Applications are only accepted between **February 1<sup>st</sup> through April 30<sup>th</sup>**.

### **Step 3: Apply to the Nursing Program through NursingCAS:**

### **Step 4: Upload the following REQUIRED documents to NursingCAS:**

- Two letters of Recommendation (professional and educational); one from a nursing professor of your current nursing program, and one from a coworker or supervisor.
- Resume
- Two sets of Official Transcripts from every college/university attended
- Copy of RN License card\* (for RN to BSN applicants only)

### **Step 5: Program Requirements for Admitted Students:**

- Physical Exam
- Proof of Immunity to Rubella, Mumps, Rubeola, Hepatitis B, Varicella
- Current CPR-C Certification CPR for Health Care Provider or CPR for the professional/rescuer
- Drug Screen and Criminal Background check
- TB QuantiFERON Gold test or Chest X-ray
- Evidence of physical and emotional health throughout the program
