**\*NOTE:** A maximum of **70 units** may be transferred from any California Community College to any California State University. Additional CSU credit may be awarded for demonstration of prior learning as operationalized through passing the NCLEX –RN examination. Examination is taken upon completion of ADN program at Santa Barbara City College.

To meet requirements for any CSUCI baccalaureate degree a student must complete two courses in **American Institutions:** (1) an approved American/U.S. History course AND (2) an approved U.S. Constitution/CA State & Local Government course. Recommend completing both at Santa Barbara City College prior to transfer to CSUCI. Units count toward BSN in CSUCI GE Area D. CSUCI Graduation requirements also include 1) **language requirement** (refer to the CSUCI catalog for specific information); 2) complete **one multicultural perspectives course (MAKE MORE PROMINENT)** (recommend completing ANTH 203 at Santa Barbara City College prior to transfer to CSUCI).

Students enrolled in the ADN program at Santa Barbara City College may concurrently enroll in the bridge RN-BSN program CSUCI after they have successfully completed the 1<sup>st</sup> semester of the ADN program. Students are enrolled into the bridge program only in summer.

An overall GPA of 2.0 is required. All nursing courses must be passed with a grade of "C" or better.
