#### Requirements to be met prior to joining the Nursing Program:

#### ADN to BSN "Summer Bridge":

- Current enrollment in a BRN approved pre-licensure Associate degree of Nursing program.
- Earn at least a 2.00 GPA in Pre-Nursing Core courses with no grade lower than a C.
- · Cumulative GPA of 2.5 or greater.

#### RN to BSN programs:

- Have or be eligible to acquire a valid California RN license.
- Be a graduate of a BRN approved pre-licensure Associate degree in Nursing program from an accredited educational institution.
- Earn at least a 2.00 GPA in Pre-Nursing Core courses with no grade lower than a C.
- Cumulative GPA of 2.5 or greater.

## **Applying to the Nursing Program**

Step I: Complete all Nursing Major Prerequisite Courses

Complete all nursing major prerequisite courses or their equivalents with a grade of C or better by the end of the spring term prior to summer admission. **Summer coursework will not be accepted as in progress work.**

# **Step 5: Program Requirements for Admitted Students:**

- Physical Exam
- · Proof of Immunity to Rubella, Mumps, Rubeola, Hepatitis B, Varicella
- Current BLS certification for healthcare professionals through AHA (two person and AED training)
- Drug Screen and Criminal Background check
- TB QuantiFERON Gold test or Chest X ray
- · Evidence of physical and emotional health throughout the program
